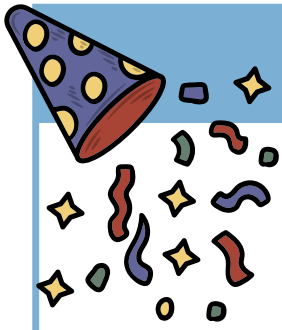

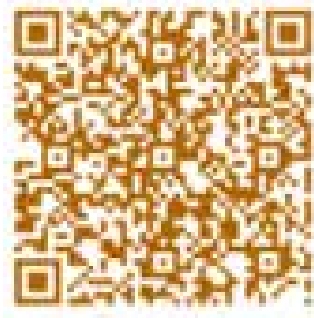

MEJORAS EN LAS INSTALACIONES

We are continuing to invest in upgrades that help our facility operate more efficiently while supporting dependable service for our customers.

Air Compressor and Dryer

A new 200-horsepower air compressor and air dryer have been added alongside our existing 150-horsepower compressor. Because roughly 95% of plant equipment relies on compressed air, this added capacity provides important backup protection and helps prevent production downtime.

Energy Optimizer Plus

Our new Energy Optimizer Plus system captures heat from washer discharge water, which leaves the machines at approximately 135 degrees. That energy is transferred to incoming water, raising it from about 55 degrees to nearly 100 degrees before it enters our washers and hot water heaters. By reusing heat that would otherwise be lost, the system helps reduce energy costs across the plant.

Steam Boiler Replacement

We also replaced a boiler that had been in service since 1980 with a new 250-horsepower boiler. Steam is essential to the operation of our washers and ironers, so this upgrade strengthens reliability throughout the plant while using less gas and electricity to operate.

Positek Portal

The Positek Portal helps return production chips back into inventory, improving organization and helping our teams keep needed items available throughout the production process.

Together, these upgrades strengthen efficiency, support smoother production, and help us continue delivering reliable service every day.

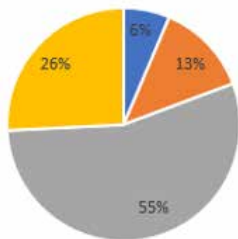
DAWN'S DESK

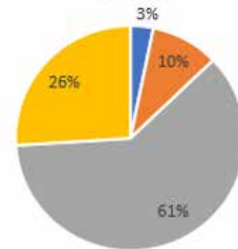

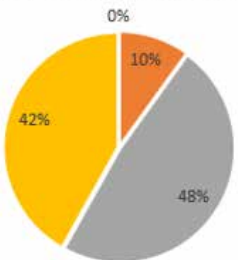

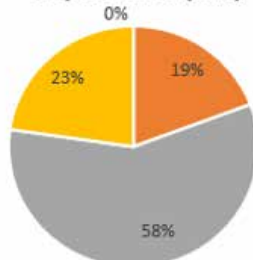

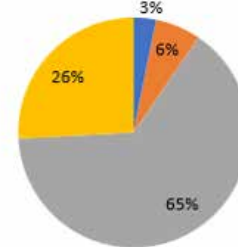

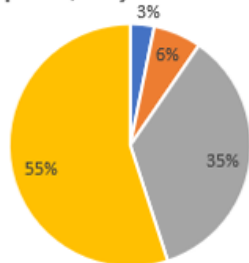

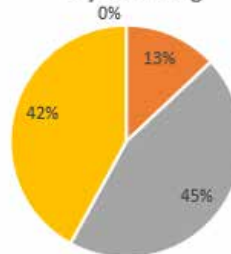

Summer Safety: Beat the Heat with Smart Practices

Summer is here, and rising temperatures can pose significant risks. Heat stress is a serious concern, but with the right precautions, we can stay safe and productive. Here are some key tips and reminders to help you beat the heat this summer.

Stay Hydrated - Drink Plenty of Water

One of the most effective ways to combat heat stress is to stay hydrated. Here are some hydration tips:

- Aim to drink at least 8 ounces of water every 20 minutes.

Understanding Heat Stress

Watch out for these symptoms:

- Heavy sweating
- Weakness or fatigue
- Dizziness or confusion
- Nausea or vomiting
- Rapid heartbeat
- Headache

Know the Emergency Procedures

In case someone shows signs of heat-related illness, it's crucial to act quickly:

- Move the person to a cooler environment.
- Provide water or electrolyte drinks.
- Cool the person with wet towels.
- Seek medical help immediately if symptoms are severe.
